Qualifiers:

- Felony of the 4th or 5th degree.
- Non-violent, non-drug, non-sexual offense.
- Resident of Medina County.
- At least 18 years of age.
- Voluntarily participate in the program as well as compliance with treatment recommendations, which may include use of medication.
- Diagnosed with Axis I severe mental illness:
 - Schizophrenia
 - Schizoaffective Disorder
 - Bi-Polar I Disorder
 - Other axis I diagnoses reviewed on a case-by-case basis
