The Home's History

The original Medina County Home was built in 1854 to provide housing for indigent persons who were unable to care for themselves. A fire destroyed the original building and it was rebuilt in 1861. This main building is still in use today, and several additions have been constructed.

For many years, the County Home was a working farm. Proceeds from farming operations helped offset the cost of running the facility. Hogs, sheep, and chickens were kept at the County Home and a dairy was operated. In 1961 the dairy was replaced with a herd of beef cattle.

In 1970 the Medina County Board of Commissioners decided to discontinue farming and raising

livestock. The remaining acreage is currently leased for farming.

Renovations, improvements and remodeling have continued throughout the years. The commitment of the Medina County Board of Commissioners is evident in the high quality of care that is provided and in the well-maintained buildings and grounds.

The Home Today

Situated on approximately 80 acres of scenic rural property, the Medina County Home is a 60-bed facility which provides primary custodial, rest-home-type care. It operates much like a licensed, private rest home but, in accordance with state law, is not subject to licensing

requirements (other than fire and safety codes).

Adult Day Care Services are also available at the Medina County Home. This service provides a comfortable setting and socialization for adults that

are not capable of full-time independent living and allows caregivers to work or have "time off" from care giving responsibilities.
