

RESEARCHING YOUR FAMILY TREE

How To Start:

Your family's memories are your most precious resource. Start with WHAT and WHO you know. Sit down with the family and fill in all the names you can. Interview the older members of your family and write down, or record on tape (*with their permission, of course*), the many interesting stories that are told, along with dates, names and places.

The Next Step:

After entering personal knowledge of family members, you may want to begin searching local records. Family Bibles, probate courts, county and municipal records offices, churches, cemeteries, libraries, and historical societies can provide additional information. Tracking down family records is part research and part detective work, but it is always enjoyable and interesting.

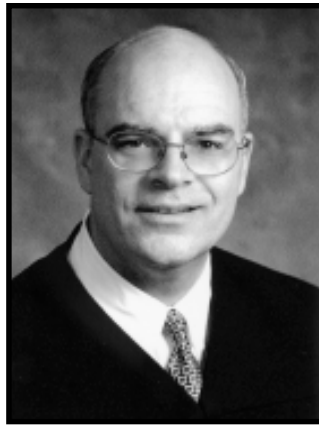

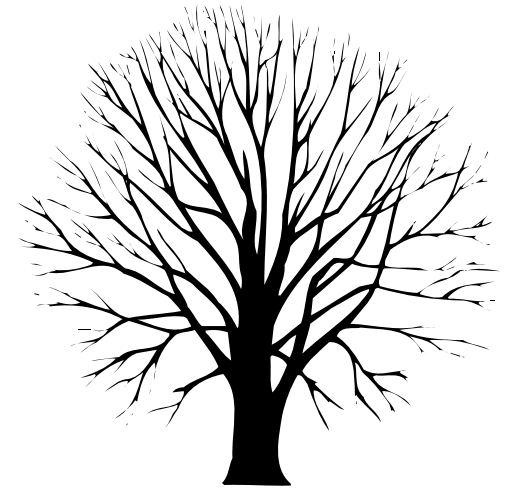

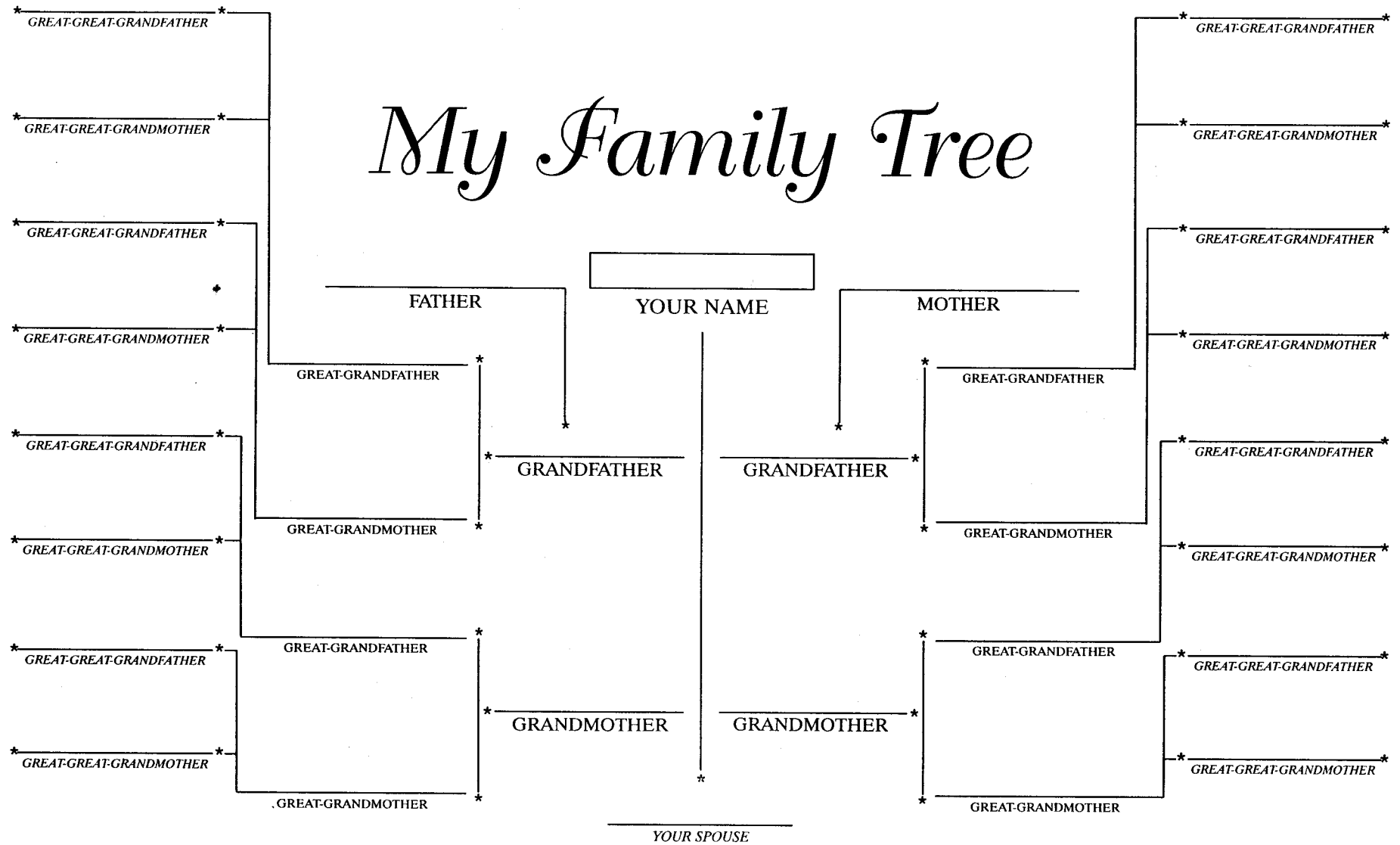
